Message "A Life Worthy of the Calling" Pastor Laura

Sacrament of Holy Communion

L: Let us open our hearts to God.

P: We open them to God and one another.

L: We give you thanks, God. You, who changed chaos into creation. You formed us in Your image and called us to dwell in Your infinite love. You gave the world into our care that we might be Your faithful stewards and show Your grace to others.

P: God, we confess that we have failed to honor Your image in ourselves and in one another. We would not see Your goodness in the world around us and so

we violated Your creation, abused one another and rejected Your love. Yet You never ceased to care for us and to prepare the way of salvation for all people.

L: At the right time, Jesus came among us; He taught, healed, saved and confronted.

P: Born into a human family and dwelling among us, He revealed Your glory. Giving Himself freely to death on the cross, He triumphed over evil, opening the way of freedom and life.

Directions to Citizens park from Salem UMC

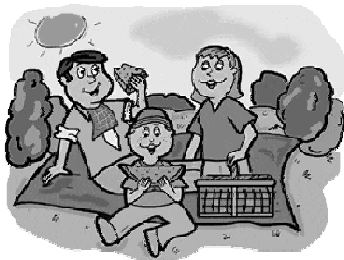
North on Hough St.
